

Selection procedure for a research position at the Department of Musicology

Number of hours worked per week: full-time, i.e. 40

Requirements:

- Completed university-level education in the field of musicology or a related field with at least a Master's degree or equivalent;
- Proven previous research activity in the field of musicology;
- Motivation to undertake research;
- Moral integrity, independence, initiative; and
- Ability to work in a team.

Applications must include:

- A short motivation letter;
- Certificates showing the level of education achieved;
- A professional CV outlining all non-academic and academic activities including publishing, teaching and other relevant experience as well as language skills; and
- An outline of the potential future research undertaken by the applicant with a view to music in the second half of the nineteenth or the twentieth century, preferably with a focus on the Czech lands.
